Thanksgiving is next week and I am beyond thankful for this incredible community. Our fundraising committees have been incredibly busy - putting on 2 events this month alone!

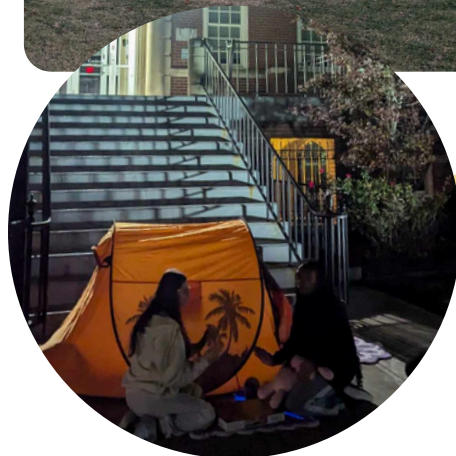

Do you LOVE to wrap gifts? Then, this is the volunteer opportunity for you! The PX supplies the wrapping paper, FKSCC brings the bows!

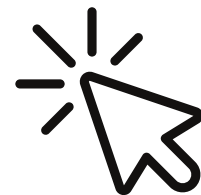

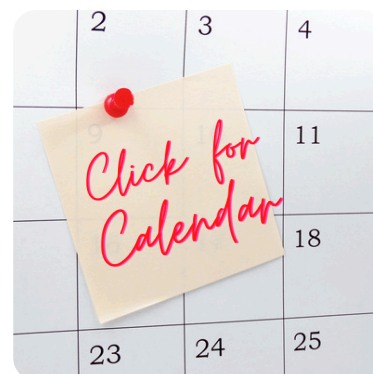

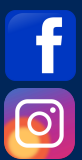
